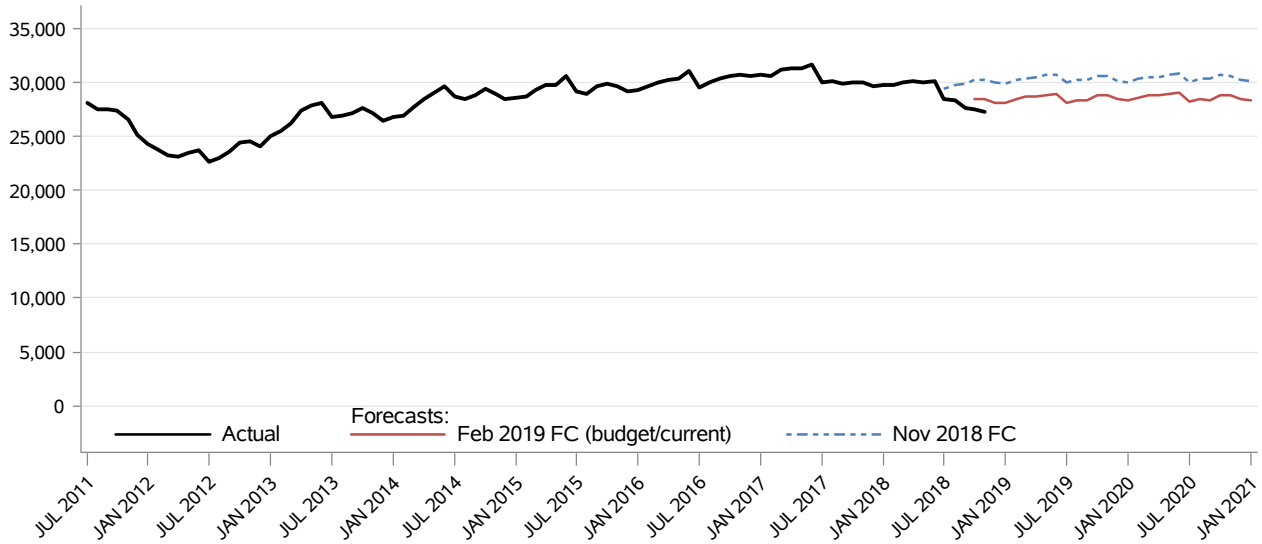


Economic Services Administration Working Connections Childcare CFC Monthly Monitoring Report

The **Working Connections Child Care** helps eligible families pay for child care while they work, attend job training, or participate in educational programs. The DSHS Economic Services Administration determines consumer eligibility and administers the subsidy payments. The Department of Early Learning sets policy for the program.

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Descriptions:

- **Actual:** Households receiving WCCC subsidy payments for dates of service within the month. The data are lag adjusted.
- **Budget Forecast:** Caseload forecast adopted by the Caseload Forecast Council to serve as the basis for the biennial or supplemental budget. The actual budget may incorporate adjustments to this forecast to reflect legislation and policy decisions by the legislature subsequent to the development of the forecast.
- **Current Forecast:** Most recent forecast adopted by the Caseload Forecast Council; may be the same as the Budget Forecast.
