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## PREFACE

This report summarizes the 13,655 Washington State adult felony sentences imposed from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 (Fiscal Year 2021). The tables in this report were generated from the Council's database, which includes data on all Sentencing Reform Act (SRA) sentences imposed during Fiscal Year 2021.

### *Washington State Sentencing Guidelines*

Washington is a presumptive sentencing guidelines state. Under the Washington Law<sup>1</sup>, individuals convicted of felonies are sentenced to a determinate term of confinement within a presumptive standard range unless a sentencing alternative or exceptional sentence outside the standard range is imposed. The 13,655 sentences imposed in FY2021 represent a 30.8 percent decrease from 19,742 sentences in FY2020.

### *Presumptive Standard Range Sentences*

The majority of Washington felony sentences are within the “standard range.” The appropriate presumptive range is determined by reference to the seriousness of the current offense, the number and type of the individual’s prior offenses and other current offenses. In FY2021, most of the felony sentences (73.3 percent) were within the standard range.

The presumptive standard range may be increased by sentence enhancements. The legislature has created sentence enhancements for felony traffic crimes involving intoxication, crimes involving a deadly weapon, crimes found to be sexually motivated, and certain drug-related crimes.

Standard range sentences are not appealable.

### *Sentencing Alternatives*

Several alternatives to standard range sentences are available for some individuals. In FY2021, 19.5 percent of sentences were ordered using alternatives to the standard range.

- The First-time Offender Waiver (FTOW) is available for individuals convicted of a non-violent offenses that have no prior felony offenses, who have not committed sex offenses, certain drug offenses, or certain offenses involving being under the influence, in which the standard range sentence may be waived. Using this alternative, a sentencing judge imposing an FTOW waives the standard range sentence and as an alternative imposes up to 90 days in jail, up to twelve months or six months of community supervision, and several other non-offense related conditions, such as community-based treatment. See RCW 9.94A.650 for further information.
- The Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) is available for the sentencing of individuals convicted of a sex offense that has no prior felony sex convictions. The alternative is limited to individuals whose current offenses do not include Rape in the second degree or any serious violent sex offenses. Individuals must also have a current offense and criminal history that permits the court to impose a standard range sentence of less than eleven

years confinement. In addition, the person may not have any adult convictions for a violent offense that was committed within five years of the date of the current offense.

A person sentenced under SSOSA receives a suspended sentence within the standard range, a jail term of up to twelve months, and conditions of the sentence that may include inpatient and/or outpatient treatment. See RCW 9.94A.670 for further information.

- The Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative (DOSA) is available for certain chemically dependent individuals. This alternative permits departure from standard range sentencing and results in a reduction of confinement time for eligible individuals combined with intensive treatment for individuals sentenced to the alternative.

An person is eligible for a DOSA alternative if:

- The conviction is for a felony that is not a violent offense and the violation does not involve a sentence enhancement under RCW 9.94A.533(3) or (4);
- The conviction is for a felony that is not a felony Driving while under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or any Drug (RCW 46.61.502(6)) or felony Physical Control of a Vehicle while under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or any Drug (RCW 46.61.504(6));
- There are no current or prior convictions for a sex offense for which the person is currently or may be required to register as a sex offender;
- There are no prior convictions in this state, and no prior convictions for an equivalent out-of-state or federal offense for the following offenses during the following time frames:
  - Robbery in the Second Degree that did not involve the use of a firearm and was not reduced from Robbery in the First Degree within seven years before the conviction of the current offense; or
  - Any other violent offense within ten years before the conviction of the of the current offense;
- For a violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act under Chapter 69.50 RCW or a criminal solicitation to commit such a violation under Chapter 9A.28 RCW, the offense involved only a small quantity of the particular controlled substance as determined by the judge upon consideration of such factors as the weight, purity, packaging, sale price, and street value of the controlled substance;
- The person has not been found by the United States attorney general to be subject to a deportation detainer or order and does not become subject to a deportation order during the period of the sentence;
- The standard range meets certain qualifications:
  - Prison-based option: the end of the standard sentence range for the current offense is greater than one year;
  - Residential-based option: the midpoint of the standard range is 26 months or less; and



- The person has not received a DOSA sentence in more than once in the prior ten years before the current offense.

There are two DOSA options available to the court for eligible individuals, depending on the length of the individual's standard range:

- i. Prison-based DOSA alternative: The court may impose a prison-based DOSA sentence on any eligible individual consisting of a period of total confinement in a state facility for one-half the midpoint of the standard sentence range or twelve months, whichever is greater and one-half the midpoint of the standard sentence range as a term of community custody, which must include appropriate substance abuse treatment in a program that has been approved by the Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery within the Department of Social and Health Services. See RCW 9.94A.660 and 9.94A.662 for further information.
  - ii. Residential DOSA alternative: If the midpoint of the standard range is 26 months or less, the court may impose a residential DOSA sentence consisting of a term of community custody equal to one-half the midpoint of the standard sentence range or two years, whichever is greater, conditioned on the person entering and remaining in residential chemical dependency treatment certified under chapter 70.96A RCW for a period set by the court between three and six months. See RCW 9.94A.660 and 9.94A.664 for further information.
- The Parenting Sentencing Alternative (or Family Offender Sentencing Alternative) is available for the sentencing of an individual who has physical custody of his or her minor child; is an expected parent; is a legal guardian or custodian with physical custody of a minor child; or is a biological parent, an adoptive parent, custodian, or stepparent with a proven and established, substantial relationship with a minor child that existed at the time of the offense.

A person is eligible if the high end of the standard sentence range for the current offense is greater than one year, and the person:

- has no prior or current conviction for a felony sex offense, a serious violent offense, or a felony offense where the person was armed with a firearm or deadly weapon in the commission of the felony;
- has no current conviction for a violent offense; and
- signs release of information waivers required to allow information regarding current or prior child welfare cases to be shared with the Department of Correction and the court.

Under this alternative, the sentencing judge may waive imposition of a sentence within the standard range and impose a sentence consisting of twelve months of community custody. See RCW 9.94A.655 for further information.

### *Exceptional Sentences*

Finally, the court may order an “exceptional” sentence that is outside the standard range of confinement or includes conditions not allowed as part of a standard range sentence when either

substantial and compelling aggravating or mitigating factors exist. In FY2021, 10.8 percent (1,475) of felony sentences were exceptional sentences, which is an increase from 7.6 percent (1,493) in FY2020.

Exceptional sentences are more likely (80.8 percent) to reduce the term of confinement to below the standard range than to increase it above the range (10.9 percent).

A small number of “within the range” exceptional sentences are ordered each year, typically to require community supervision beyond the amount allowed under the standard range or to require treatment in situations where such treatment may not be required as part of a standard range sentence. In FY2021, 8.3 percent (122) of the exceptional sentences fell within the standard sentence range, which is a decrease from 9.6% in FY2020.

Exceptional sentences may be appealed by the defense or by the prosecution and defendants have a right to a jury trial on aggravating factors.

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY<sup>2</sup>

- In FY2021, the total number of felony sentences imposed in Washington decreased 30.8 percent, from 19,742 sentences in FY2020 to 13,655 sentences in FY2021.
- Changes in the rate and number of sentences imposed between FY2020 and FY2021 are summarized as follows:

- In FY2021, 5 individuals were sentenced to life in prison as persistent offenders under the “three strikes” provision of RCW 9.94A.030 (37)(a). In addition, one sex offender was sentenced to life in prison under the “two-strike” provision of RCW 9.94A.30 (37)(b). The 6 new persistent offender sentences imposed in FY2021 was a 60 percent decrease from the 15 sentences in FY2020.
- The percentage of felony sentences that resulted in a prison sentence increased from 36.1 percent in FY2020 to 40.3 percent in FY2021.
- The average prison sentence in FY2021 was 42.9 months, up from 42.3 months in FY2020. The average jail sentence length in FY2021 was 3.5 months, up from 3.1 months in FY2020. Overall, the average sentence length of all felony sentences increased from 16.9 months in FY2020 to 19.0 months in FY2021.
- In FY2021, the number of sentences imposed for Violations of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act (VUCSA) decreased by 59.2 percent from the previous year. The number of sentences for “dealing” offenses decreased by 20.8 percent and the number of sentences for “non-dealing” offenses decreased by 66.1 percent. A recent court decision, *St. v Blake* ruled that the statute for simple possession of a controlled substance was unconstitutional. Resulting legislation reduced simple possession to a misdemeanor.
- The number of First-time Offender Waivers (FTOW) granted decreased from 1,279 in FY2020 to 907 in FY2021, a 29.1 percent decrease. Approximately 62 percent of FTOWs were below the standard range minimum, and 37.6 percent were within the standard range. While the overall number of FTOW sentences declined, the percent as compared to the overall number of felony offenses imposed in the fiscal year increased slightly, from 6.5% of all sentences in FY2020 to 6.6% in FY2021.
- The number of Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) sentences imposed by the court increased from 60 in FY2020 to 65 in FY2021, an 8.3 percent increase. While the overall number of SSOSA sentences declined, the percent as compared to the overall number of felony

offenses imposed in the fiscal year increased, from 0.3% of all sentences in FY2020 to 0.5% in FY2021.

- The number of Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative (DOSA) sentences imposed by the court decreased from 2,216 sentences in FY2020 to 1,628 in FY2021, a decrease of 26.5 percent. While the overall number of DOSA sentences declined, the percent as compared to the overall number of felony offenses imposed in the fiscal year increased, from 11.2% of all sentences in FY2020 to 11.9% in FY2021. Among the 1,628 DOSA sentences in FY2021, there were 956 Prison-based DOSA sentences and 672 Residential DOSA sentences.

\*\*Sex offenders who have no prior felony sex convictions may receive a sentence under the Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) if they are not convicted of a serious violent offense with a sexual motivation finding or of Rape 1, Attempted Rape 1, or Rape 2 and have a current offense and criminal history that permits the court to impose a sentence within the standard range of less than eleven years confinement. Under current law, individuals sentenced under this alternative receive a suspended sentence and may receive up to twelve months in jail, community supervision for three years or the length of the suspended sentence (whichever is greater), inpatient or outpatient sex offender treatment, crime-related prohibitions and requirements for affirmative conduct. If the violations of the conditions of supervision occur, the original suspended sentence may be imposed.

## EXCEPTIONAL SENTENCES

Under provisions of the Sentencing Reform Act (SRA), every adult felony offense has a presumed range of punishment determined by the seriousness of the offense, the number and type of other current offenses, and the number and type of prior adult and juvenile offenses. The presumptive range for certain offenses may be increased for weapon usage, for dealing drugs in a school or other protected zone, or for certain drug offenses committed in a correctional facility. The presumptive range is decreased by 25 percent if the current offense is an attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation to commit a felony. Some alternative sentences are possible under the First-time Offender Waiver (FTOW) for first time offenders, excluding violent, sex, or certain drug offenses. In addition, the Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) allows suspended sentences for certain individuals, and the Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative (DOSA) allows for reduced confinement time for eligible individuals.

The SRA presumes that, in most cases, a sentencing judge will impose a sentence within the standard range for the offense. An exceptional sentence is a sentence outside the standard range (Alternative sentences under FTOW, SSOSA, Parenting Alternative, or DOSA are not considered exceptional sentences). An exceptional sentence is allowed if there are substantial and compelling reasons supported by the record. An aggravated sentence must be based on a factor listed in RCW 9.94A.535, and the defendant has a right to a jury trial on the facts and circumstances underlying an aggravating factor. The judge is required to record these reasons in writing. Some exceptional sentences do not result in incarceration outside the standard range, but are used to provide sentence conditions not otherwise permitted (*e.g.*, lengthy community supervision). The prosecution or the defense may appeal exceptional sentences.

The following tables summarize the reasons recorded by sentencing judges when imposing exceptional sentences. Reasons are summarized separately for mitigated sentences, aggravated sentences, and sentences within the standard range.

## **SEX OFFENDER SENTENCING UNDER RCW 9.94A.507**

The 2001 Legislature enacted 3ESSB 6151 – The Management of Sex Offenders in the Civil Commitment and Criminal Justice Systems. The new system is often called “determinate plus.” Essentially, any person who is not a persistent offender, who is sentenced for any one of the offenses enumerated in RCW 9.94A.507 (1)(a)(i) or (ii), or an attempt to commit any of those offenses, or is convicted of any sex offense, except failure to register, and has a prior conviction for a “two-strike” offense under RCW 9.94A.031(36)(b), is to receive an indeterminate sentence. The only exception is for individuals 17 years old or younger at the time of the offense who are sentenced for Rape of a Child in the First Degree, Rape of a Child in the Second Degree, or Child Molestation in the First Degree.

The minimum term of the sentence is to be set in the standard range according to the seriousness level of the offense and the individual score. The minimum term may also constitute an exceptional sentence as provided by RCW 9.94A.535. The maximum term is the statutory maximum sentence for the offense. Individuals sentenced to an indeterminate sentence are eligible for earned release pursuant to RCW 9.94A.728, have the opportunity for sex offender treatment while incarcerated, and may be eligible for the Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) as provided in RCW 9.94A.670.

Individuals sentenced under the “determinate plus” scheme fall under the purview of the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board (ISRB) through the maximum term of the sentence. The ISRB periodically reviews “determinate plus” individuals who have served their minimum term and decides whether to release the person. Individuals sentenced as “Determinate plus” may remain in custody up to their statutory maximum, depending on the decisions of the ISRB. Those released from prison will be supervised by the Department of Corrections and will remain on community custody through the maximum term of the sentence.

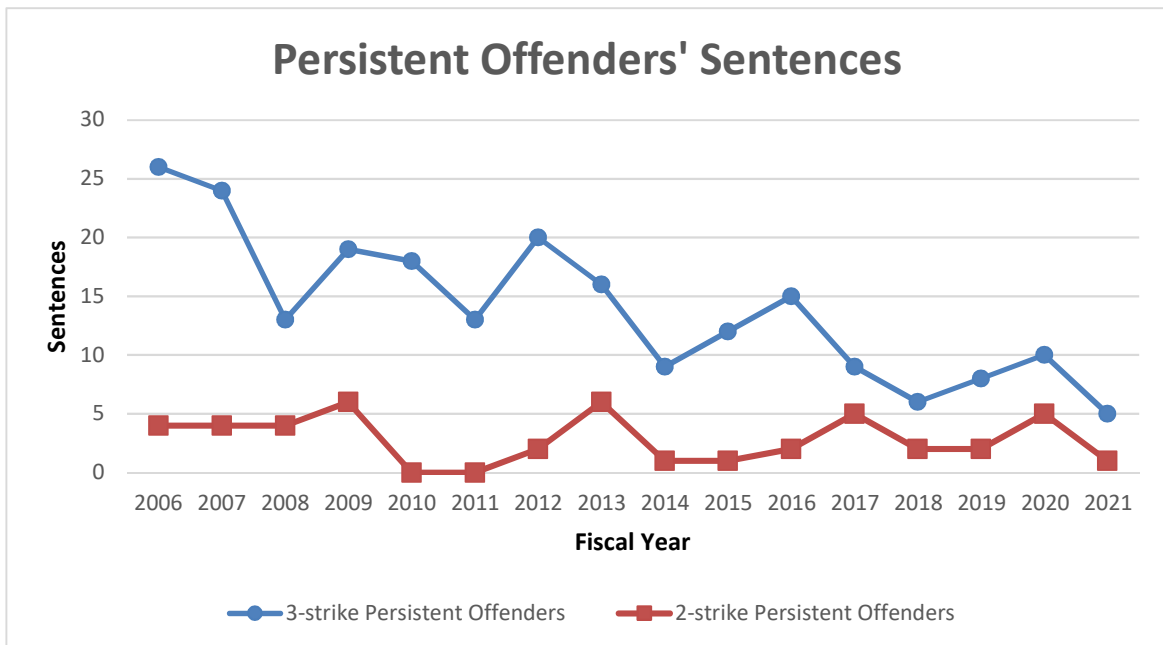
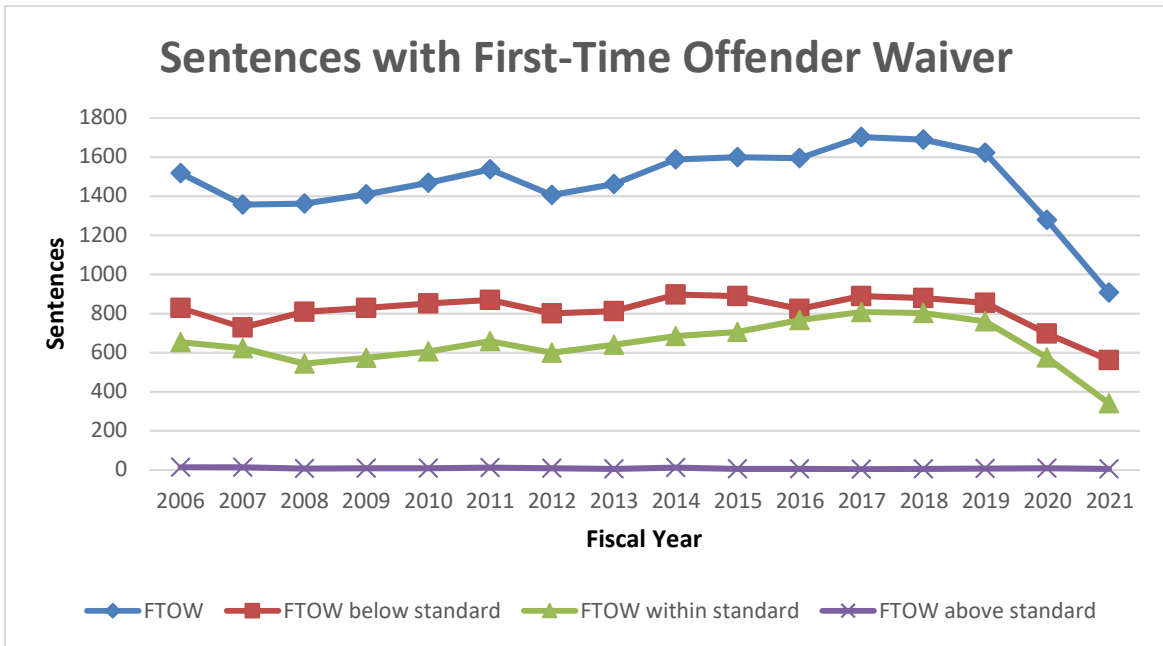


## Percentage of Violent Sentences in Jail and in Prison

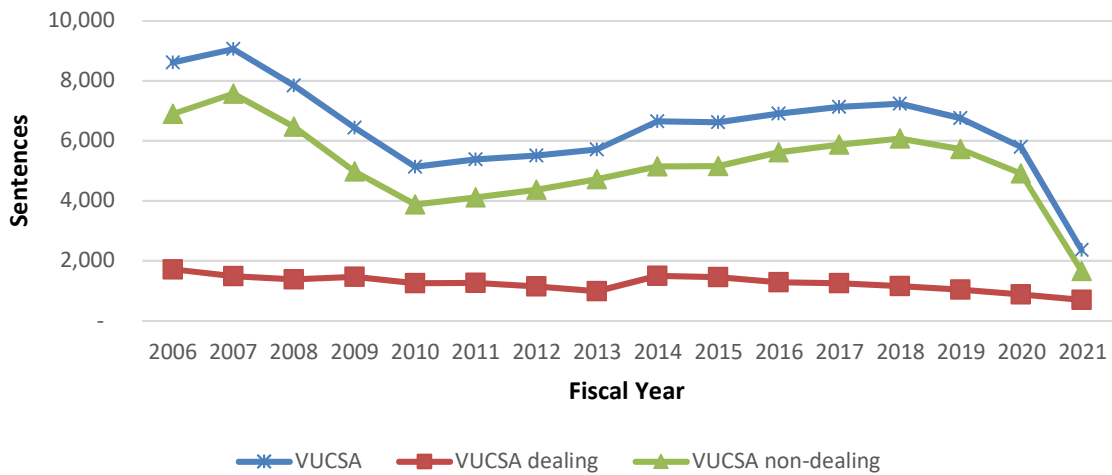

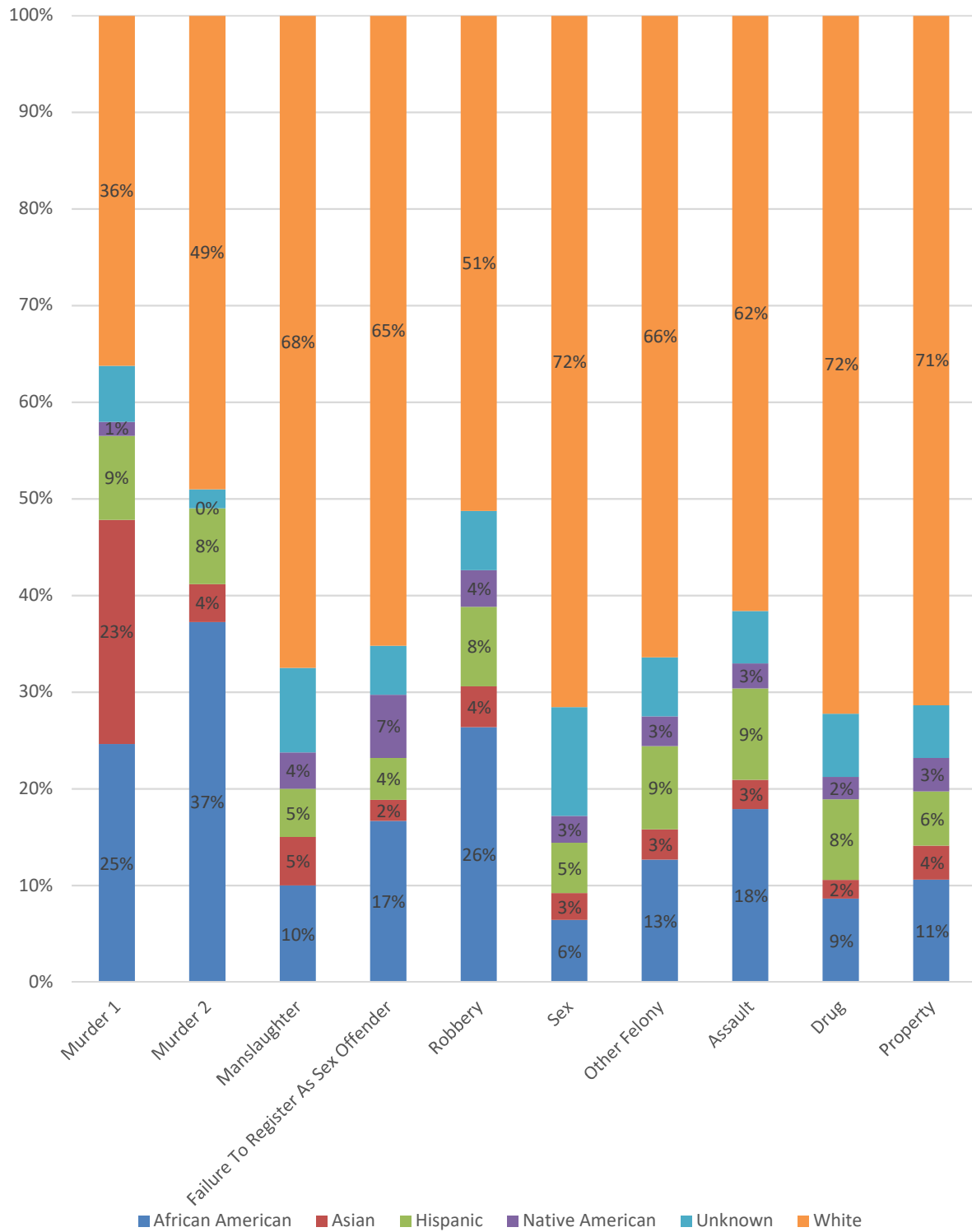


## Crime Distribution by County FY2021

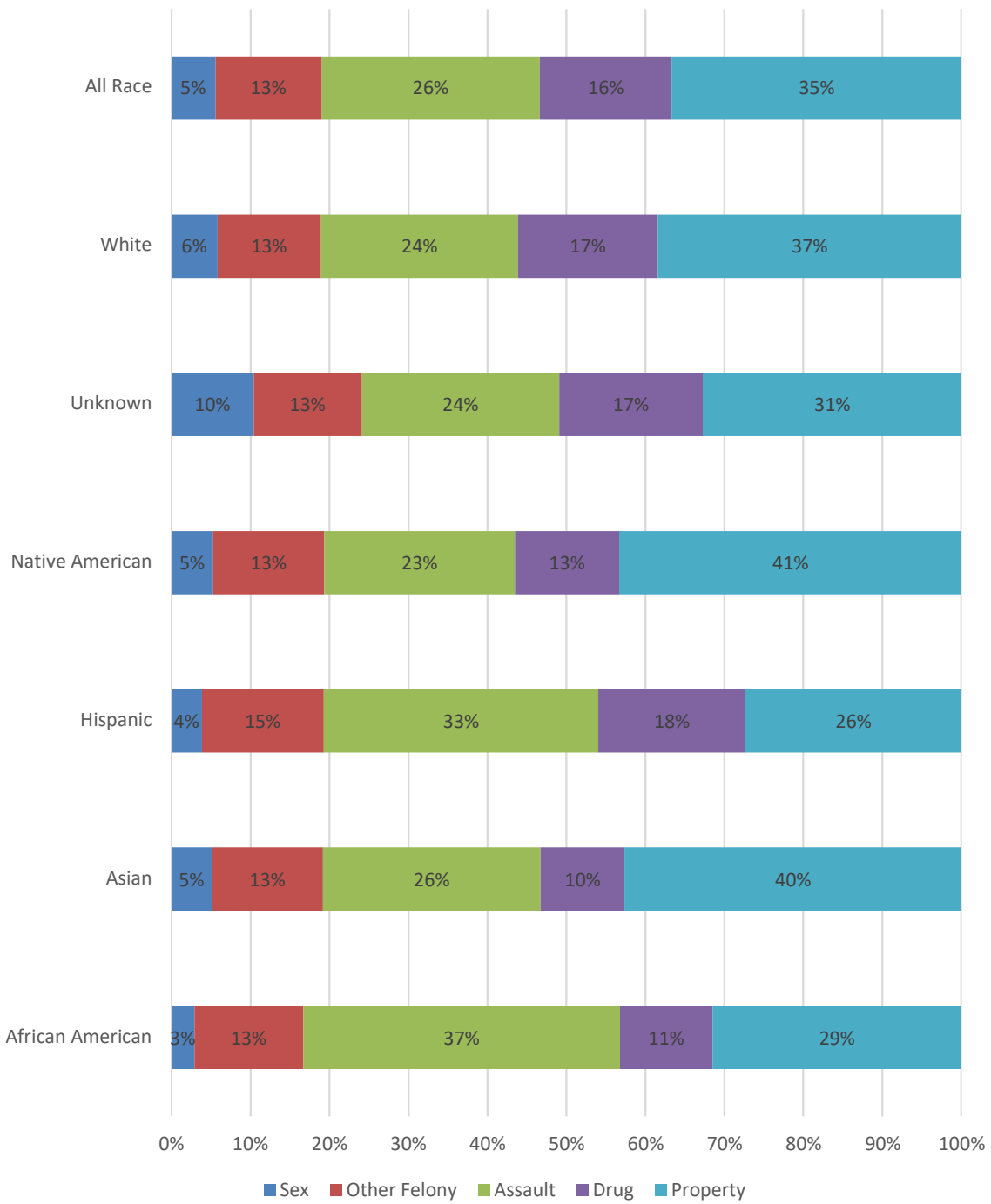




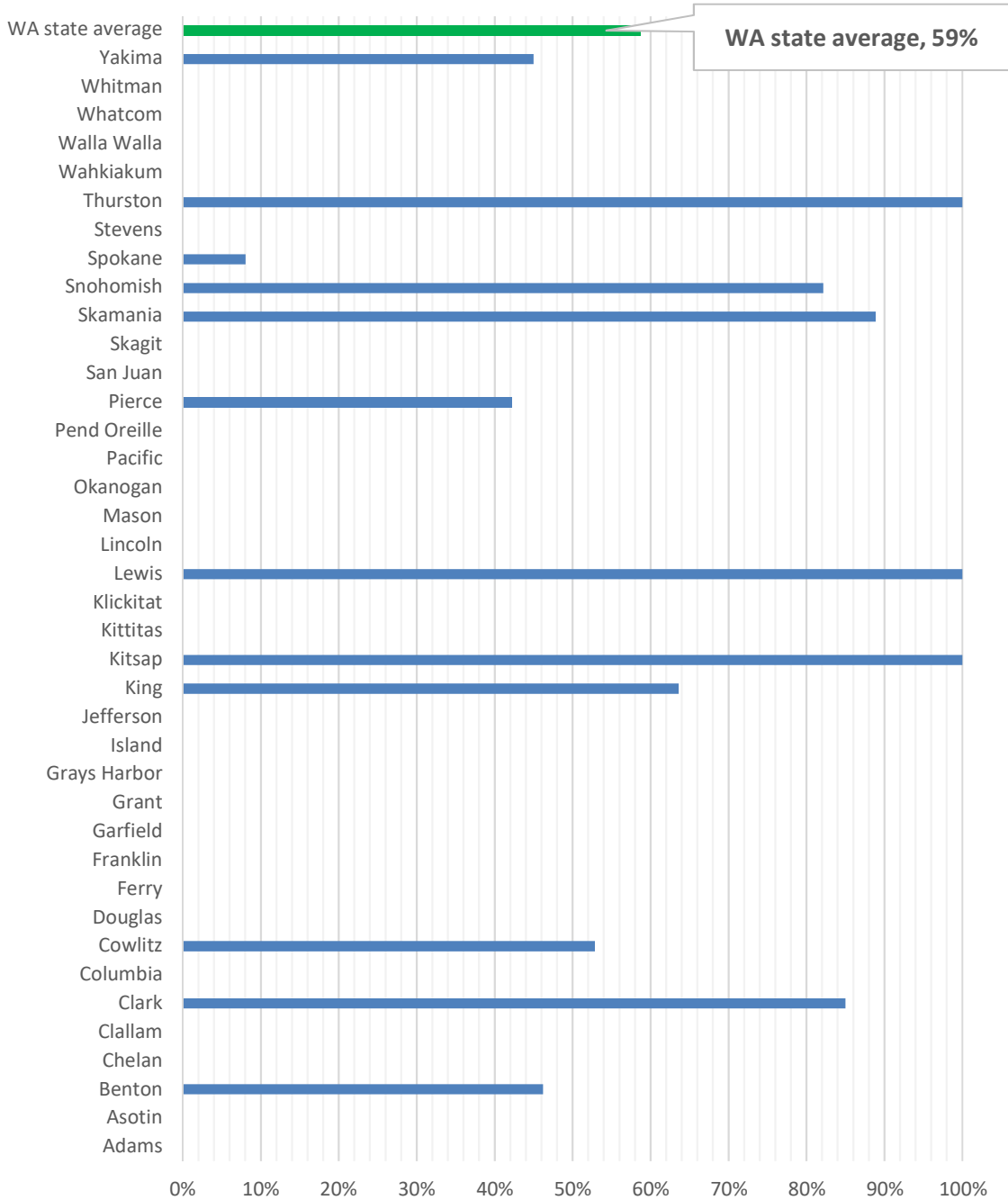
## Racial Distribution by Crime Category FY2021

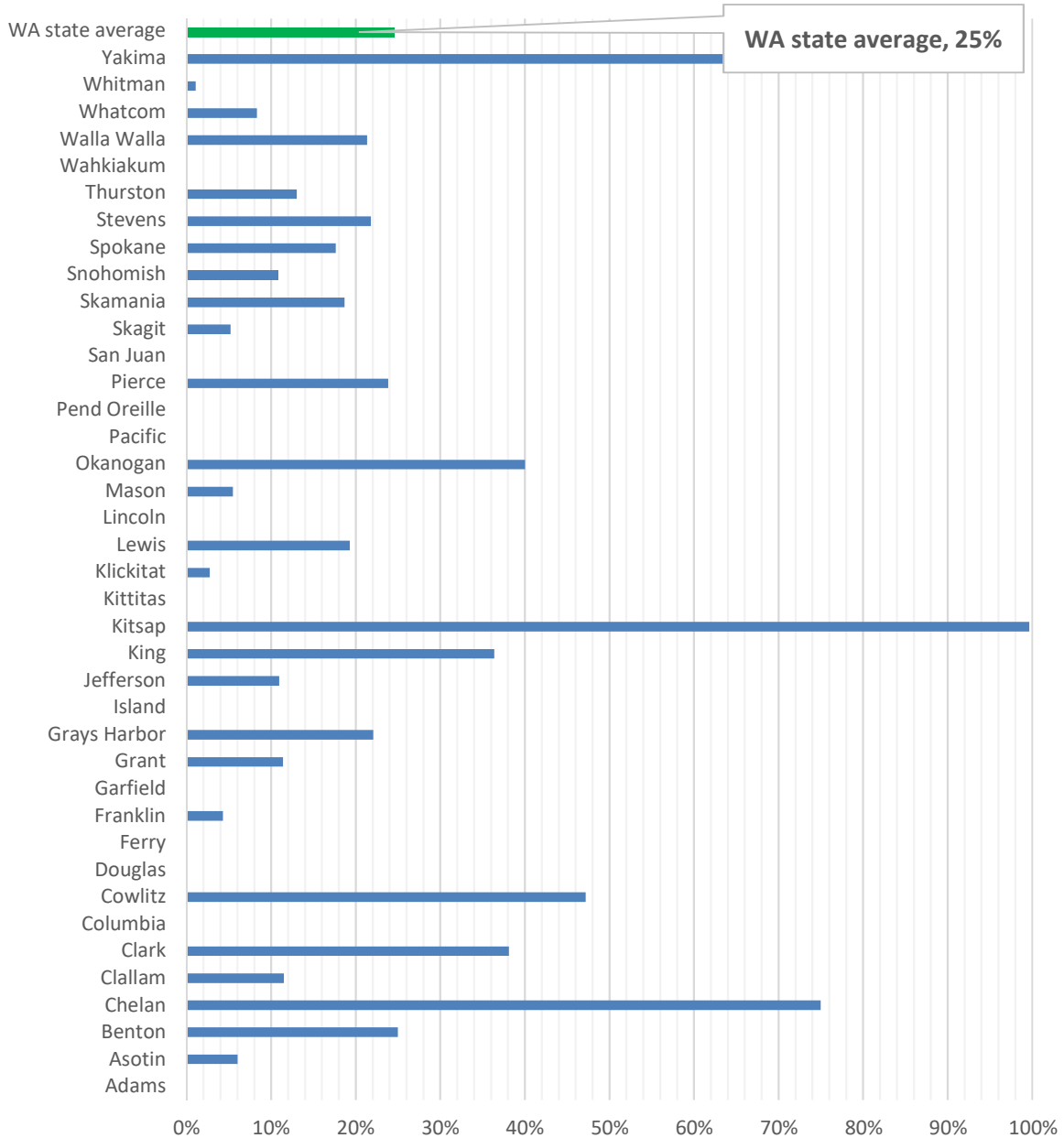

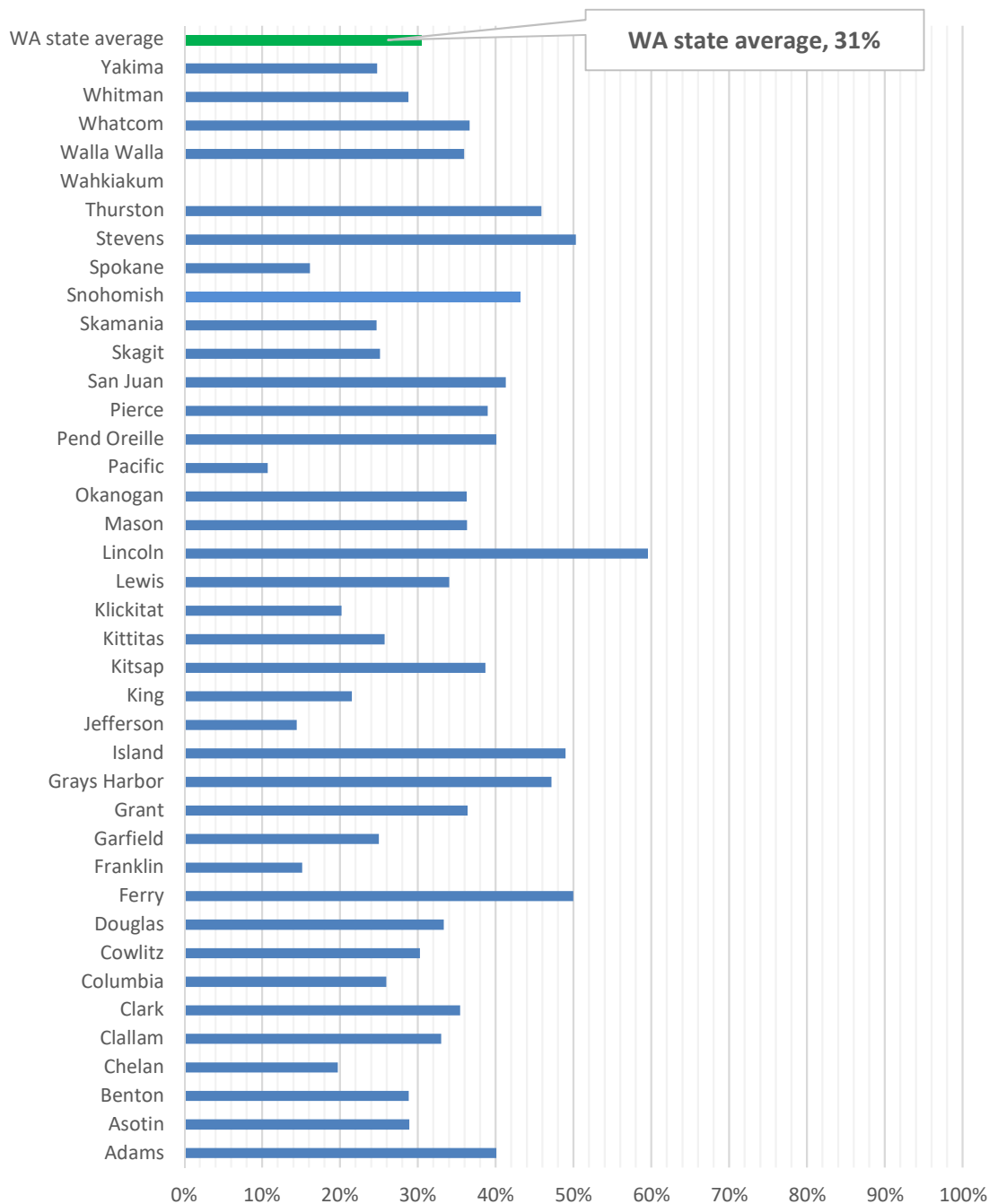

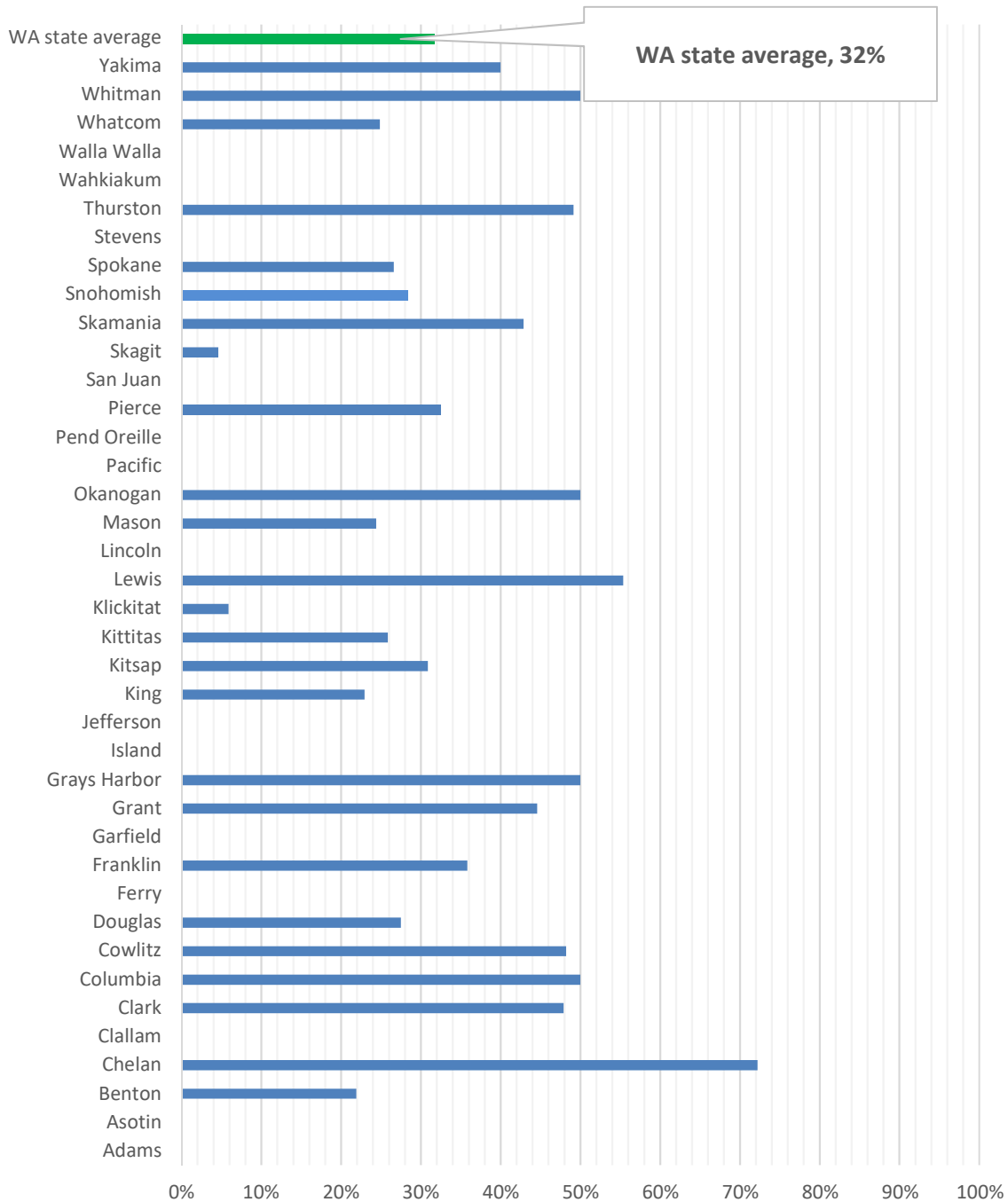

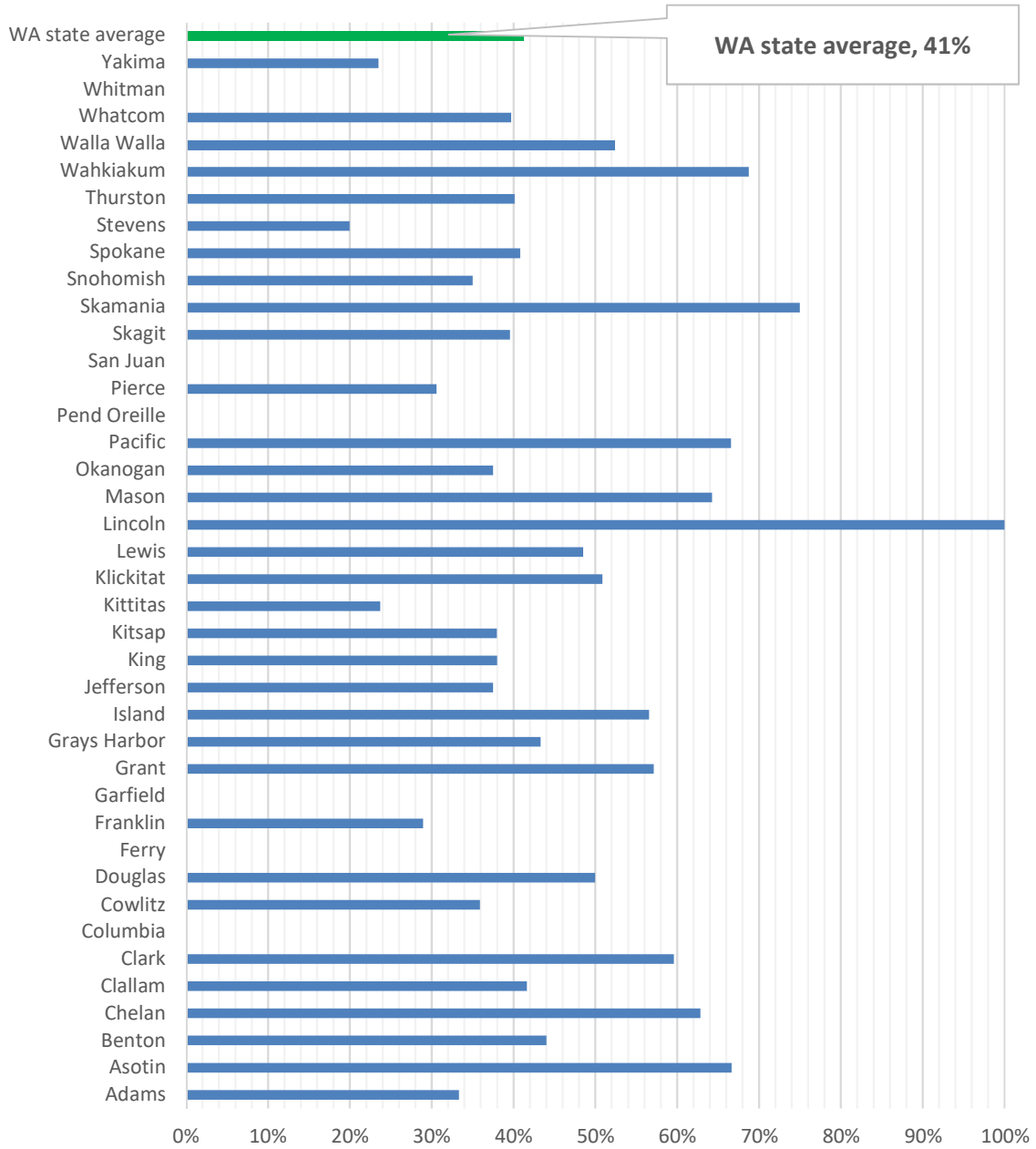

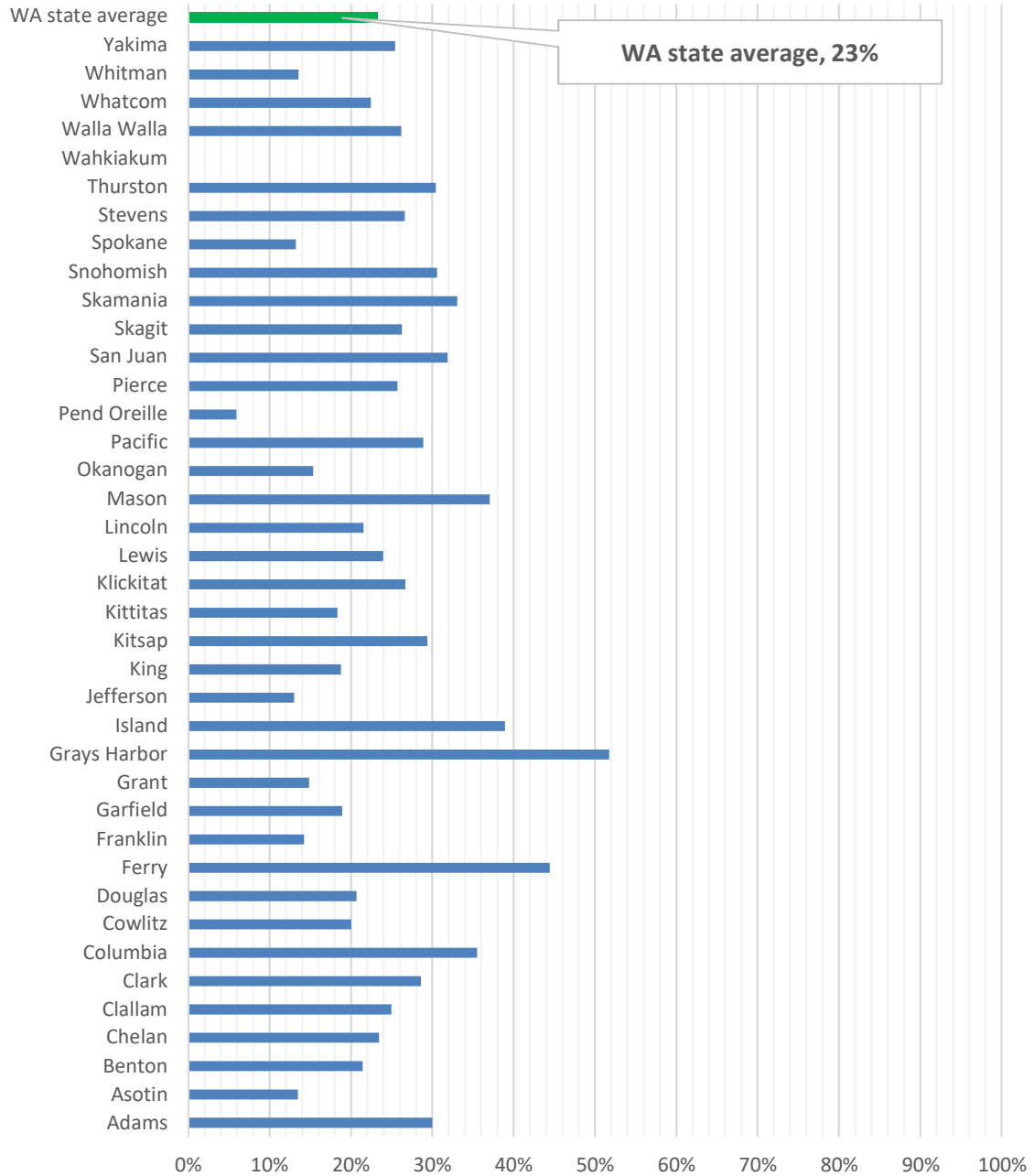


## Where-In-The-Range - Sex FY2021



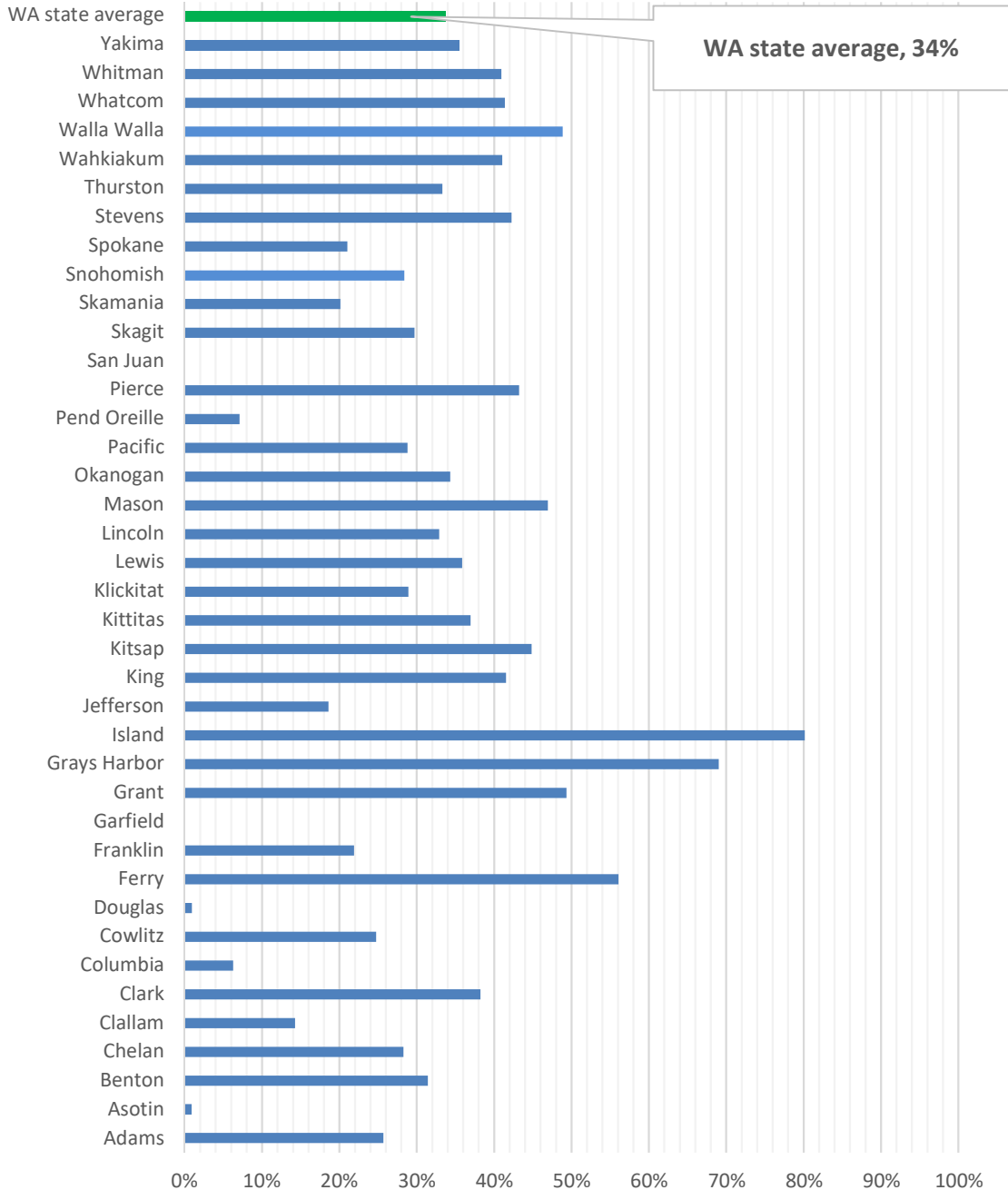

## Where-In-The-Range - Drug FY2021



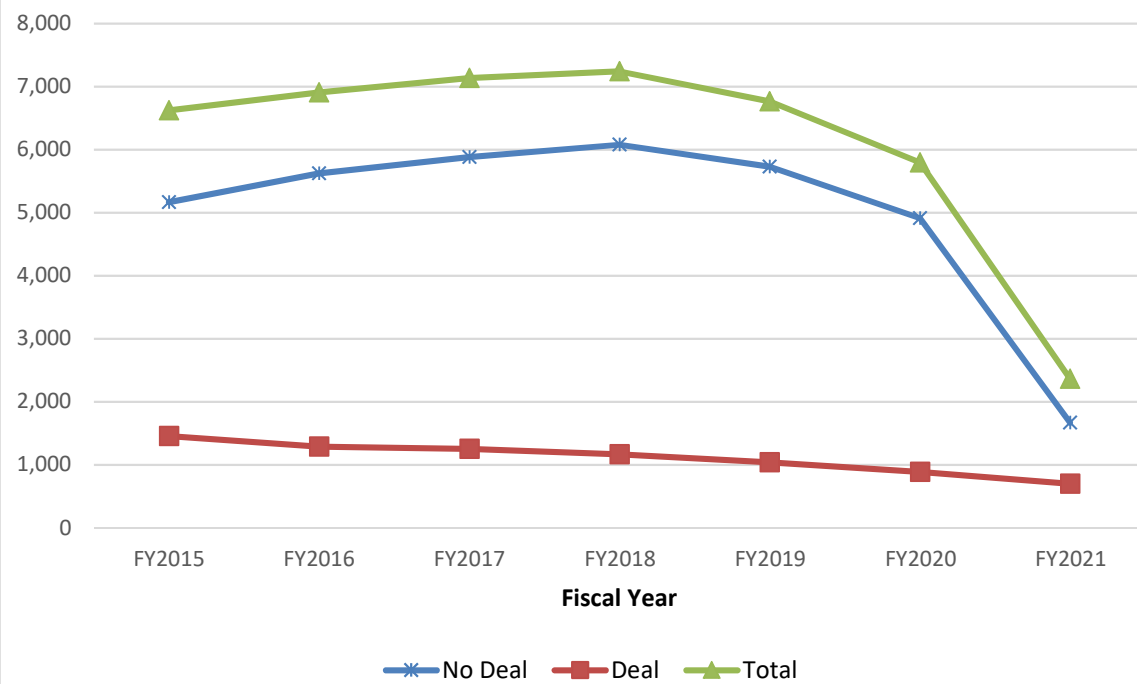

## Where-In-The-Range - Other Felonies FY2021



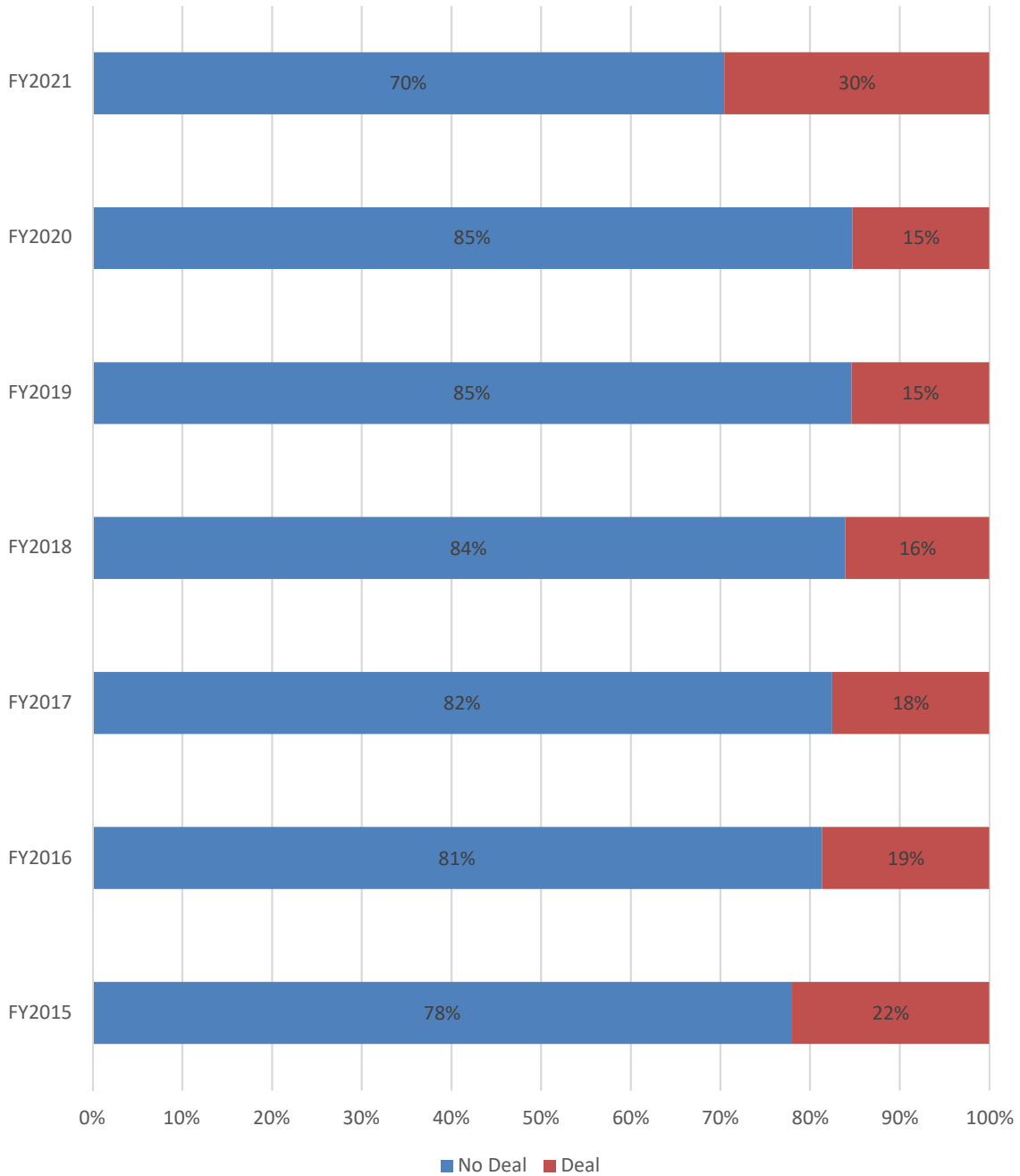
