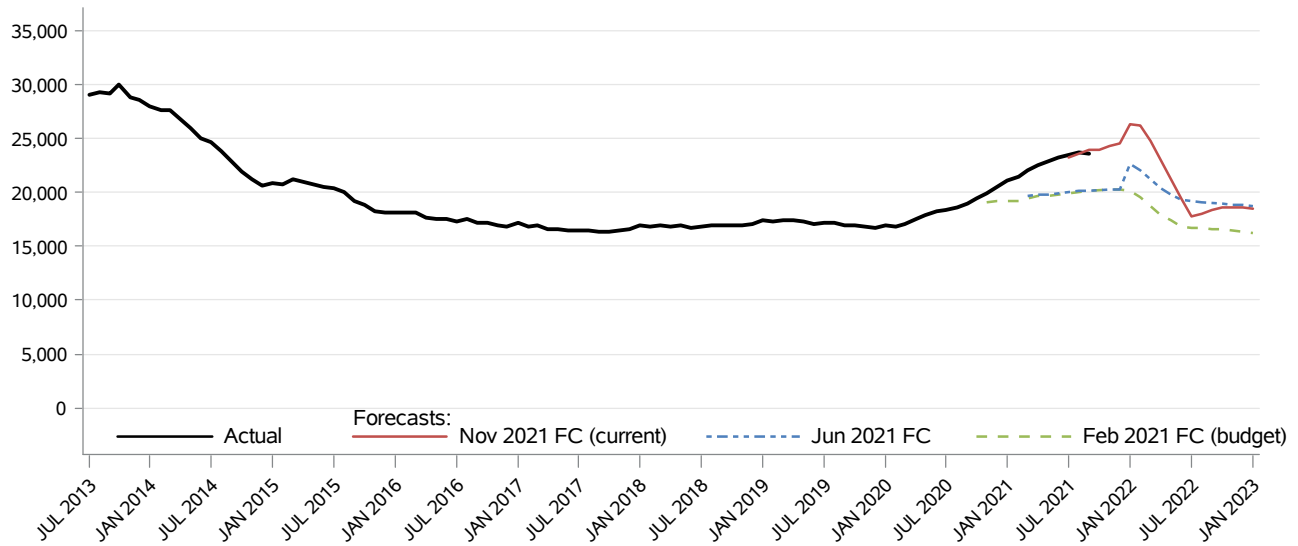


Medical Services Categorically Needy Pregnant CFC Monthly Monitoring Report
