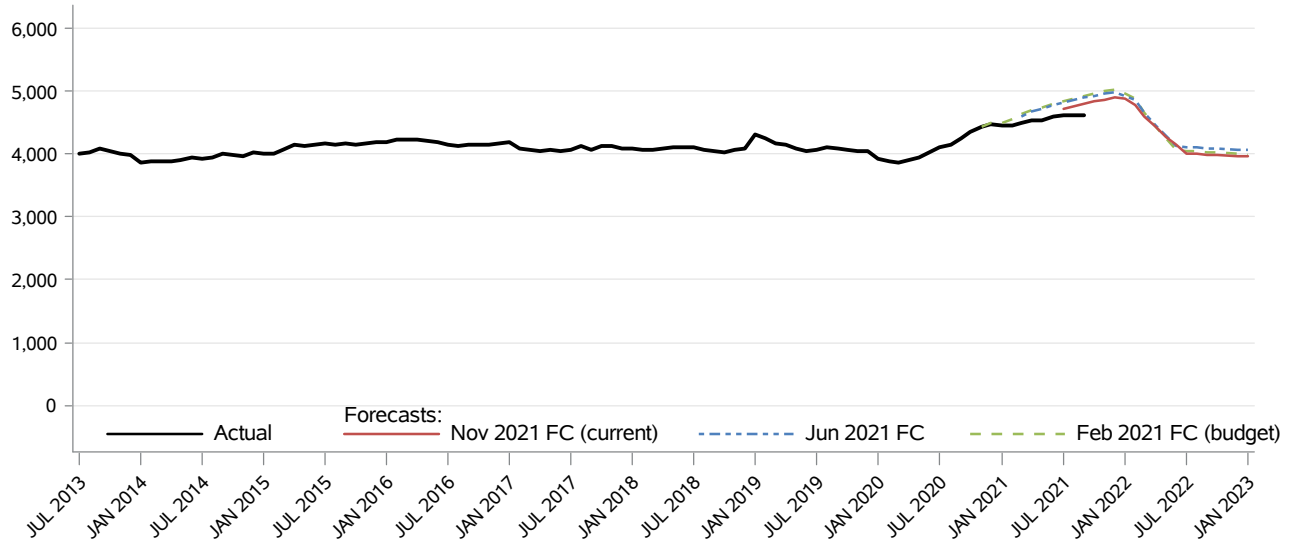


Medical Services Medically Needy Aged
