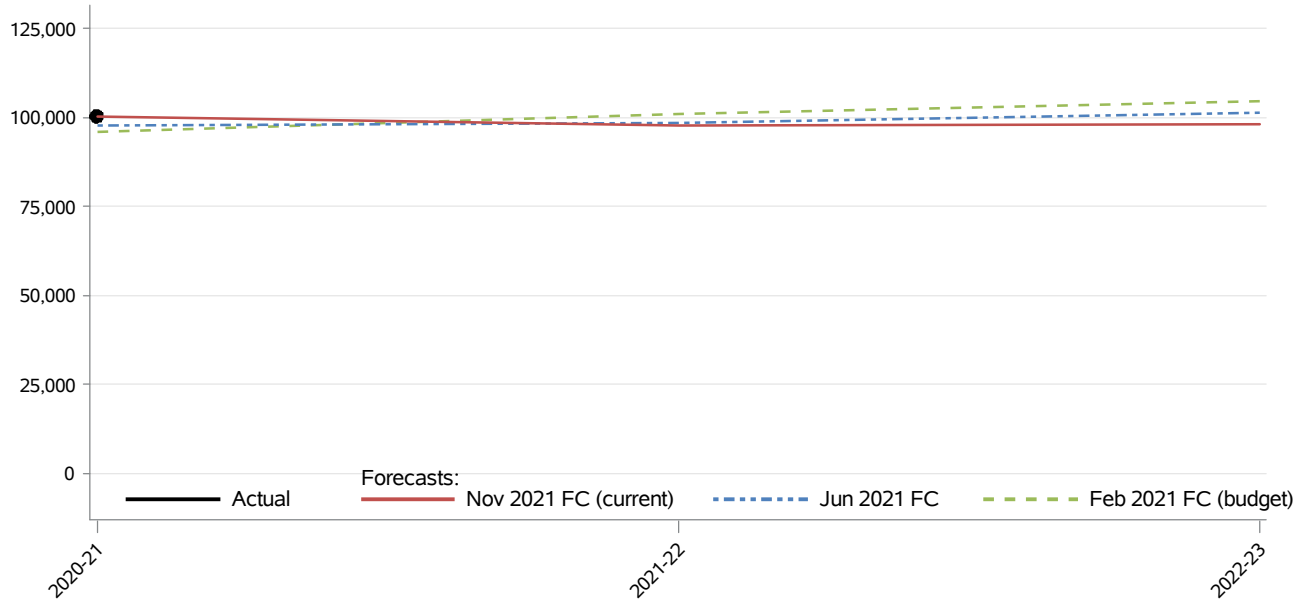


## Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) Washington College Grant CFC Monthly Monitoring Report

Descriptions:

- **Actual:** Average annual headcount of students enrolled in an institution of higher education according to scholarship award year of eligibility.

The actual budget may incorporate adjustments to this forecast to reflect legislation and policy decisions by the legislature subsequent to the development of the forecast.
- **Current Forecast:** Most recent forecast adopted by the Caseload Forecast Council; may be the same as the Budget Forecast.
